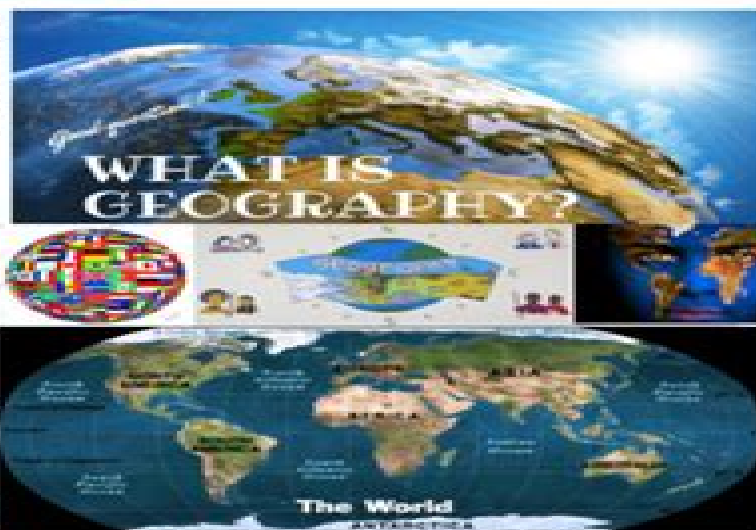

Continents and Oceans of the World

There are 7 continents in the world



Latitude and longitude are measured in degrees. Latitude runs East to West. There are 360 lines of latitude. The equator is the line of latitude that splits the earth into two hemispheres. Lines of longitude run North to South. There are 360 lines of longitude. The prime Meridian runs through London.

Map symbols help us to understand what appears on the map. They give us a useful guide to what we can expect to see when we're out and about exploring. Maps have a key so we know what the symbols mean.

Grid references allow you to find 10m² areas (4 figure references) or pinpoint spots (6 figure references) on a map. When working out grid references you use the bottom numbers first then the side numbers second.

Six-figure grid references

In your head, you should be able to divide all sides of the square into ten equal sections. By doing this, you can pinpoint locations within the square – these are called six-figure grid references.

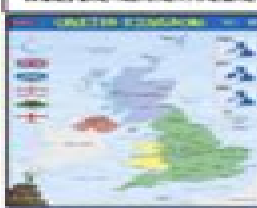
