

*National Estuary Program Coastal Condition Report*, 2006 Reports on the conditions of the nation's 28 National Estuary Program NEP estuaries presenting two types of monitoring data 1 data collected as part of EPA's National Coastal Assessment NCA and 2 data collected by the individual NEPs or NEPs in partnership with stakeholders Ratings in this report are based solely on NCA monitoring data for four primary indices of estuarine condition water quality index sediment quality index benthic index and fish tissue contaminants index Overall condition ratings were provided for NEP estuaries of the Northeast Coast the Southeast Coast the Gulf Coast the West Coast Puerto Rico and the nation Content was provided by EPA and the U S Geological Survey USGS in cooperation with 28 individual National Estuary Programs and local state and federal agencies **National Coastal Condition Report** Kevin Summers, 2001 National Coastal Condition Report II, 2005
