

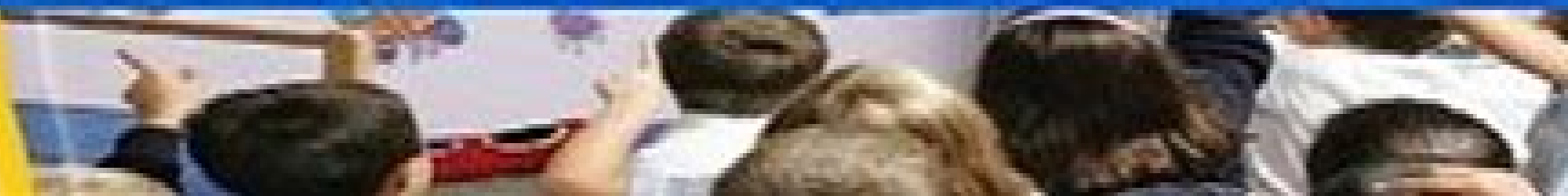

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Step 2 Builds on the teaching in Step 1 It provides 12 weekly units and follows a similar format of daily revision and consolidation along with extension topics for the week These include additional tricky words and the alternative ways of writing the vowel sounds as well as alphabet work

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Step 3 With a further 12 weekly units Step 3 aims to consolidate the learning in Steps 1 and 2 New tricky words are introduced as well as spelling patterns plus short and long vowels
