

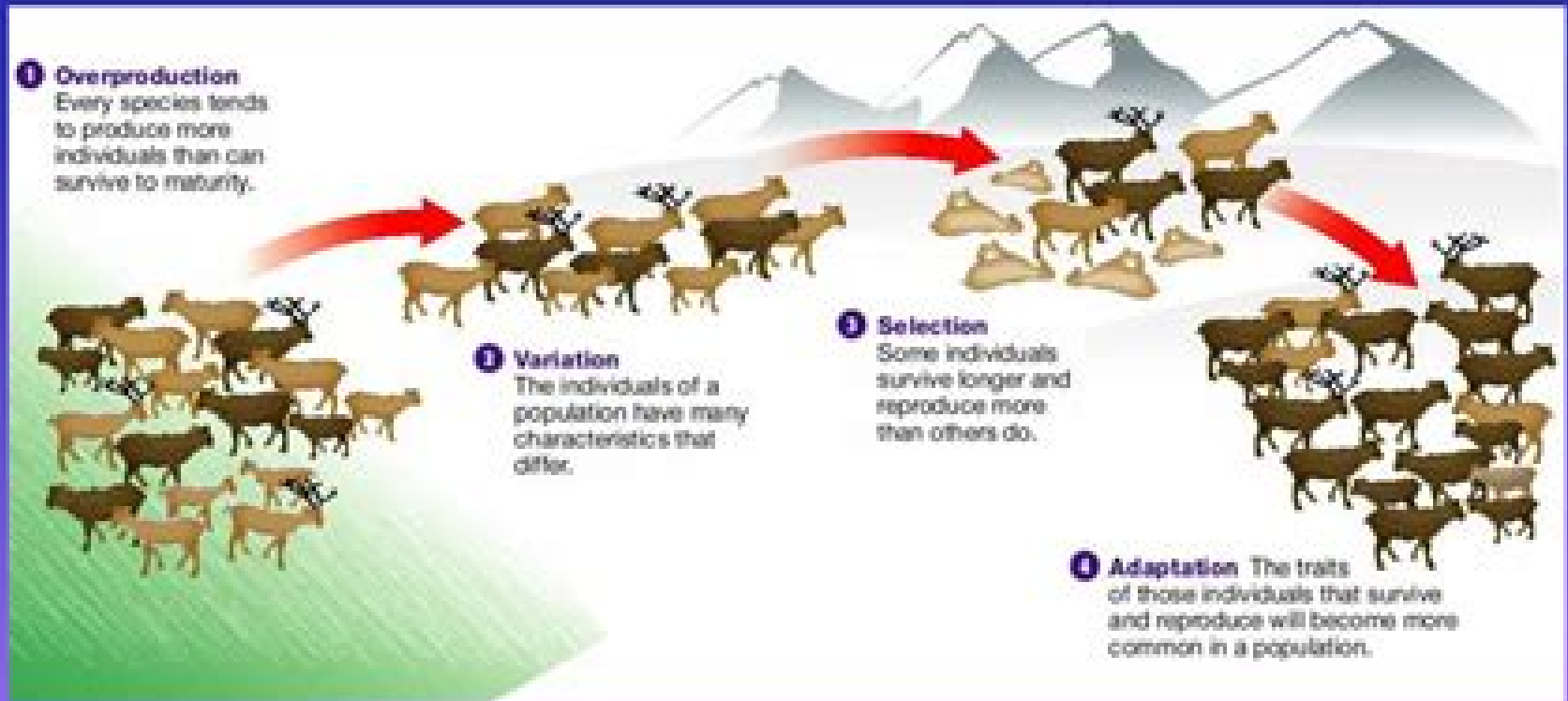
Natural Selection
