W:. Grand Lodge, Free and Accepted Masons of Arkansas, and you have violated the 1st tie of the Entered Apprentice Degree and the 10st tie of the Master Mason's Degree.

Specification of Charges 4.0.61

The purchase, sale or use of cipher rituals of the three Symbolic Degrees of Masonry is forbidden; and any Mason who shall hereafter purchase, sell or use anything purporting to be a cipher ritual or written, printed or otherwise delineated ritual or exposition of Masonry shall be expelled from Masonry.

Pursuant to Sections 4.0.4 and 4.0.165, the Trial Commission has set the date and time of the trial to be April 17, 2010, beginning at 1:00 p.m. at the Grand Lodge office, 7th and Scott Streets, Little Rock, Arkansas.

Under Section 4.0.155 you may act as your own defense, or you may select a Brother (a Master Mason in good standing, other than the Senior or Junior Wardens of your Lodge or a Member of the Board of Appeals and Grievances) to act in your defense, or if you prefer I will appoint a Brother to act in this capacity. Please inform me at least 10 days prior to April 17, 2010, if you desire to have your defense appointed by the Trial Commission. This Trial Commission's proceedings are not governed by Rules of Law, and character witnesses will not be allowed.
