President Grant said it was a source of great satisfaction to him to see such a large attendance. He said he had no recollection of any opening of conference on a week day when some of those attending had to stand. He was grateful to see so many present. He hoped all would be fed on the bread of life and that whatever he said would be for the good of himself and the congregation. When the opening prayer was made, he said, and a supplication went up to God that law and order might be upheld, he knew what the keynote should be. President Grant then read a selection from the Doctrine and Covenants to the effect that laws and rulers should be upheld and order maintained. That he said meant that men should be able to labor without running the risk of being killed by someone who objects to their doing such work. The President said he was
