Once that is done, now is the time to strike a conversation about what do they do when. For example, ask them when do they brush their teeth or take a bath. They might answer: Morning! similarly, name some activity that they do throughout the day and get answers or help them answer - afternoon, evening and night!

Here is an interesting activity to do for that, draw or take print outs of the daily activities that your child(ren) do and let them label: morning, afternoon, evening and night (you can refer to activity 1 at the end of the lesson).

Now, tell your child(ren) that we are going to be more specific. show them the analog as well as digital clock and let them guess what is it.
