2. What four elements make up 98% of all living matter?

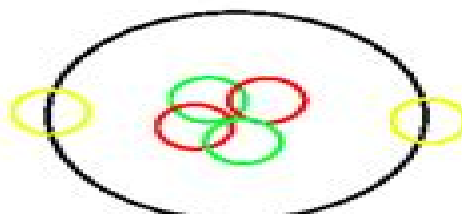
Carbon, Oxygen, Hydrogen, and Nitrogen

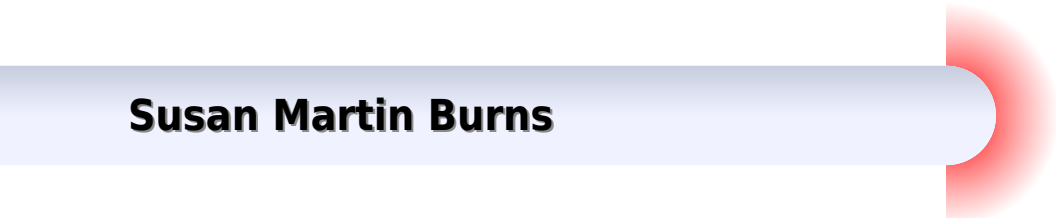
4. Sketch a model of an atom of helium, showing the electrons, protons, and neutrons, and atomic nucleus.
