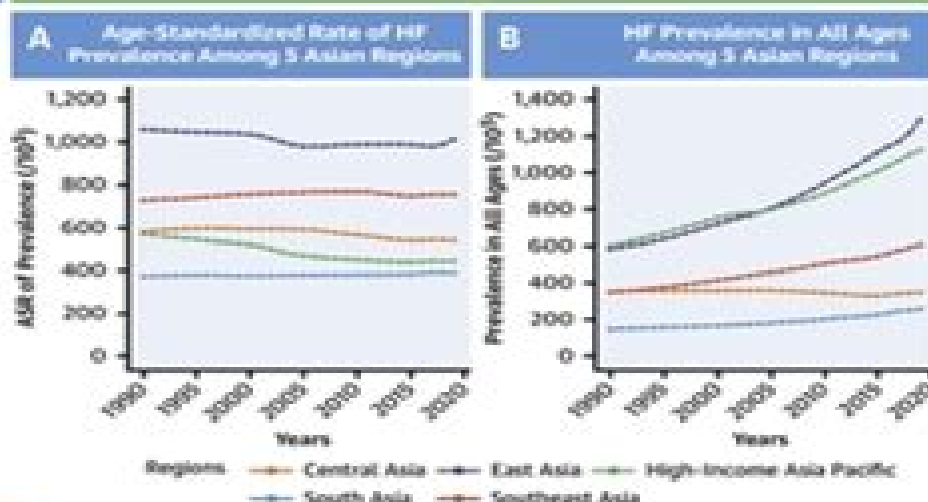

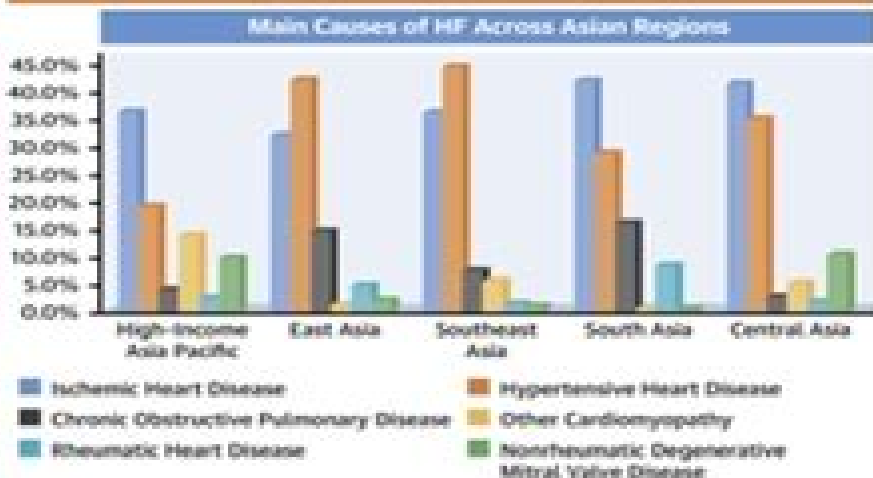
The Prevalence of HF in Asia is High:
