Le Horla Guy de Maupassant, 2024-02-21 **Le Horla** Guy de Maupassant, 2012-03-28 Le Horla et autres nouvelles fait partie des incontournables de la littérature de collage. Tout bon professeur qui se respecte sait qu'en donnant lire ce recueil il conduira la lecture bien de ses élèves. A cela une raison : le style de Maupassant. Car qu'on n'aille pas prétendre que la jeunesse actuelle se fasse peur la lecture du Horla. Les phrases, les mots, le tempo musical rendent le texte fantastique et pour reprendre les mots de Louis Ferdinand Céline le lecteur est alors emporté dans la rame motivée même par l'auteur. Mais il y a aussi une autre raison de lire Le Horla. Cette raison c'est Freud. Oui le père de la psychanalyse aurait certainement profité d'une lecture de Maupassant. Malheureusement nulle trace d'une quelconque filiation. On ne peut qu'en faire l'hypothèse devant une parenté si frappante. Ainsi l'interrogation constante que mène Maupassant sur la question de l'identité et de la psychose et elle peut influencer sur la théorie de la psychanalyse. De toutes les manières, Freud a tout fait pour donner ses thèses un aspect scientifique, alors une origine littéraire ne pouvait que faire tâche. La présente édition reprend l'édition originale de Ollendorff en 1887 dans laquelle figure la seconde version du Horla sous forme de journal intime. Ce livre s'adresse ceux qui curieux de relire un classique souhaite comprendre comment le phénomène fantastique est intimement mêlé à une réflexion sur le sujet et l'identité.

Contes et nouvelles de Maupassant Emmanuèle Grandadam, 2007 L'histoire littéraire est jalonnée d'affirmations si convaincantes qu'elles se répètent l'environnement de Maupassant en a souvent fait victime. On a pu dire que ses volumes de récits courts taient la simple réunion hasardeuse et opportuniste des derniers textes parus dans la presse. Un certain nombre d'éditeurs ont alors redistribué les contes et nouvelles sur le lit de Procuste regroupant de façon parfois arbitraire les récits courts autour de parcours thématiques et génériques. Pour une poétique du recueil se propose de montrer que loin d'être la rencontre fortuite de textes, les volumes de contes conçus par Maupassant jouent avec les possibilités du livre et avec les voisinages de textes qu'il permet. Comment ignorer que sur les quelque trois cents contes parus dans les journaux, Maupassant a laissé dans ses cartons un tiers de sa production et a ventilé les deux tiers restants dans quinze recueils qu'il a composés lui-même. Pourquoi l'édition posthume ne les a-t-elle pas plus souvent pris en compte. Selon quels critères les textes ont-ils été triés par l'éditeur dans ses quinze ouvrages. Que peut nous apprendre l'archéologie des recueils. Dans quel sens les récits ont-ils été triés pour prendre place dans le volume. Quel est le rôle des nouvelles d'ouverture et de clôture. Les combinaisons nées de la discontinuité soufflent le chaud et le froid sur le recueil de récits courts et en font une forme idéale pour susciter maints effets de sens et donner la vision d'un monde qui vacille entre le jour et la nuit. Contrairement au titre ironique d'un des volumes, ne s'équilibrent pas et le rire exacerbe presque toujours la dissonance. Le recueil tel que l'a voulu l'éditeur apporte au maupassantophile un supplément de sens à la lecture des contes. Pour une poétique explore chacun des quinze ouvrages comme une aventure.

Le Horla Guy De Maupassant, 2022-06-12 Le Horla trouve son origine dans une courte nouvelle de Maupassant Lettre d'un fou publiée sous le pseudonyme de Maufrigneuse en 1885 dans le quotidien Gil Blas qui développe d'abord la même histoire sans que le nom de Horla n'y soit mentionné Maupassant reprend ensuite les principaux éléments de Lettre d'un fou pour écrire deux autres versions de l'histoire sous le titre Le Horla La première version du Horla est publiée en 1886 dans Gil Blas La seconde version plus connue et plus longue paraît en 1887 dans un recueil de nouvelles homonyme Les trois versions de l'histoire se présentent sous trois formes littéraires différentes Lettre d'un fou comme son titre l'indique est un courrier fictif la première version du Horla est un récit cadre et la deuxième version prend la forme d'un journal intime inachevé qui laisse craindre que son propriétaire n'ait sombré dans la folie ou ne se soit suicidé La rédaction du Horla coïncide avec les prémices de la folie de Maupassant de plus en plus victime d'hallucinations et de doublement de la personnalité cause de la syphilis qu'il a contractée Il tentera lui aussi de se suicider en 1892 Inspirations de Maupassant L'aspect fantastique du récit vient du doute chez les lecteurs quant à l'existence du narrateur ou la réalité des faits qu'il rapporte Maupassant souffrait lui-même de troubles mentaux il avait l'impression de se voir l'extérieur de lui ou qu'il traitait la personne qu'il voyait dans le miroir La conclusion qui voque le suicide comme solution peut être vue comme le reflet du sentiment de l'auteur de ne plus voir d'issue Le Horla est l'aboutissement d'une série de contes qui font refléter un sentiment de double puis un être monstrueux ou surnaturel Maupassant a renouvelé le thème du double présent dans la littérature fantastique depuis Hoffmann en se servant des dernières réflexions scientifiques et médicales la mode notamment l'hypnose et les travaux sur l'hystérie de Charcot la Salpêtrière² Toutefois l'impact de Charcot dans l'œuvre de Maupassant ne doit pas être exagéré en outre les relations entre l'écrivain et le médecin demeurent floues Maupassant dans la deuxième version du Horla cite deux reprises le nom de Mesmer ainsi que l'école de Nancy pionnière l'époque en matière d'hypnose en concurrence avec les travaux de Charcot⁴ Certains auteurs affirment que Maupassant pourrait avoir fréquenté l'école de Nancy
