Martin Luther King, Jr., (January 15, 1929-April 4, 1968) was born Michael Luther King, Jr., but later had his name changed to Martin. His grandfather began the family's long tenure as pastors of the Ebenezer Baptist Church in Atlanta, serving from 1914 to 1931; his father has served from then until the present, and from 1960 until his death Martin Luther acted as co-pastor. Martin Luther attended segregated public schools, graduating from high school at the age of fifteen; he received the B. A. degree in 1948 from Morehouse College, a distinguished Negro institution of Atlanta from which both his father and grandfather graduated. After three years of theological study at Crozer Theological Seminary, where he was elected to membership in a predominantly white senior class, he received the M. Div. degree in 1951. He then completed his Ph.D. in graduate studies at Boston University, where he was elected to membership in Phi Kappa Phi, receiving the degree in 1955. In 1956 he was elected to membership in the National Academy of Arts and Letters for his intellectual and artistic attainments.
