Asian governments to hedge in the post Cold War environment seems likely to continue to pose challenges for U S management of alliance and other relations with Asian governments seeking more independence and freedom of action inclining some to seek closer ties with China among others Policymakers in the United States should not overreact to such maneuvers recognizing that such hedging continues to provide a prominent role for the United States as the region s well recognized security stabilizer and economic partner of choice In particular Chinese government leaders found that their overt efforts in the late 1990s to compel Asian governments to choose between a rising China and the United States failed in the face of Asian governments long unwillingness to do so The government should learn from this experience in seeking to advance its leadership in Asia without the overt competition with China that would try to force Asian governments to make such a choice probably with negative implications for U S leadership in Asia
