People with pacemakers should:

- ALWAYS keep the radio more than 8 inches (15 cm) from their pacemaker when the radio is turned DN.
 - Not carry the radio in the breast pocket.
- Use the ear opposite the pagemaker to minimize the prohential for interference.
- Turn the radio OFF immediatoly if there is any reason to suspect that interference is taking place.

Medical Devices - Hearing Aids

Some digital wireless radios may interfere with some hearing aids. In the event of such interference, you may want to consult your hearing aid manufacturer to discuss alternatives.
