Specifically, in paragraph 8 not only does Dog wait for Maggie to awake for a whole week, but he also -persuades her to go with him to the riverbank- so he can show her that life can go on. In addition, when Maggie wishes to turn her back on Fox, Dog says, -He's all right. Let him be.- This shows that Dog stands by his friends.

Another reason Wild and Brooks show readers a true friend is a loyal friend is that Fox is disloyal to both Maggie and Dog and therefore he is a fake friend. In paragraph 18, Fox tells Dog and Maggie they looked -extraordinary- when they were running together. However, while he said kind words, Fox was secretly planning a way to break up Maggie and Dog's friendship. For instance, after he persuades Maggie
