

The Life Cycle of a Cheetah

There are three main stages in a cheetah's life cycle: cub, adolescent and adult.

The gestation period for a cheetah is between 90 and 95 days.

Female cheetahs give birth to litters of three to five cubs on average.



Cub:

When they are born, cheetah cubs are unable to see. They have a thick mass of fur that helps them to camouflage into the background. It offers them protection from heat during the day and cold during the night.

Cheetah cubs are vulnerable to predators and, in the wild, the death rate of cheetah cubs can be as high as 90%. Their mothers move them around often to try to keep them safe.

Adolescent:

The adolescent stage of a cheetah's life is between approximately 18 and 24 months. They leave their mother but stay with their newly independent siblings while they become more adept at hunting.



Adult:

Cheetahs mature when they are around 24 months old. Female cheetahs tend to live solitary lives and hunt alone whereas males usually live in coalitions (groups) of two or three. The life expectancy of an adult cheetah in the wild is between 10 and 12 years.
