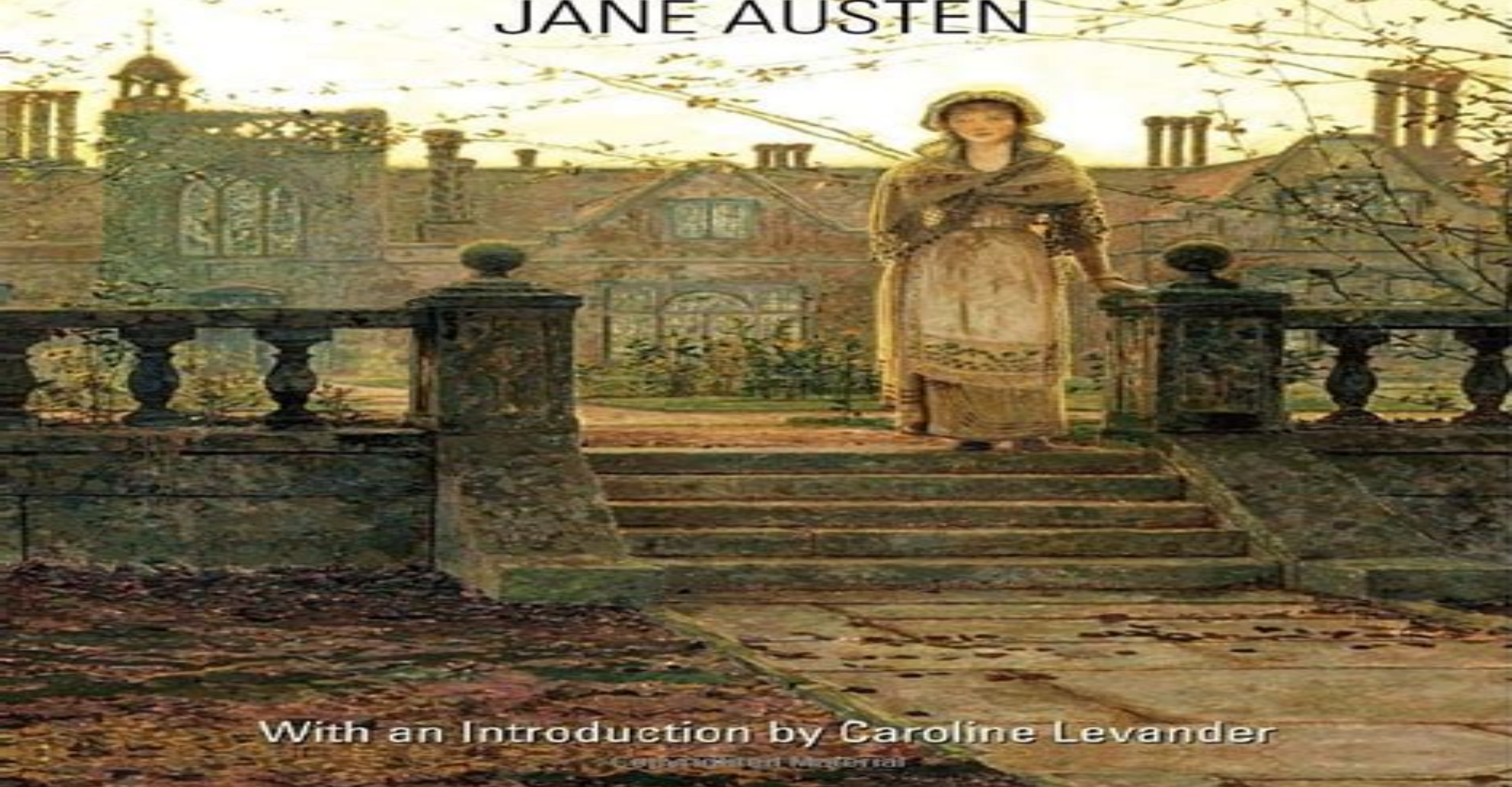

and trees hens and chickens all very much like one another Writing and accounts she was taught by her father French by her mother her proficiency in either was not remarkable and she shirked her lessons in both whenever she could What a strange unaccountable character for with all these symptoms of profligacy at ten years old she had neither a bad heart nor a bad temper was seldom stubborn scarcely ever quarrelsome and very kind to the little ones with few interruptions of tyranny she was moreover noisy and wild hated confinement and cleanliness and loved nothing so well in the world as rolling down the green slope at the back of the house
