reveal that while the projected mean climate changes bring some good news for the Sudan extreme negative variability costs the Sudan cumulatively between 2018 and 2050 US 109 5 billion in total absorption and US 105 5 billion in GDP relative to a historical mean climate scenario without climate change

actually did adapt relative to those that did not indicating that the prospects of closing the productivity gap through encouraging adaptation in less well endowed households are limited
