Chapter 1

- 1. The definition of anatomy and physiology. Anatomy and physiology is the study of the structure of the human body and how it works. Anatomy examines the structures of body parts such as their forms and organization. Physiology considers the functions of body parts such as what they do and how they do it. Anatomy is the study of body structures and relies on examination of those structures. Physiology is the study of the functions of the body parts and relies more on experimentation.
- 2. The characteristics of life. Growth which is an increase in cell number and size and increase in body size, reproduction which is the production of new cells and organisms, responsiveness which is the reaction to a change inside or outside of the body, movement which is a change in body position or location or motion of internal organs, metabolism which is the sum of all chemical reactions in a living system known as energy and nutrient cycling. Some chemical reactions of metabolism are respiration which is acquiring energy. Most organisms do it by taking in oxygen and giving off carbon dioxide. Another is digestion which is breaking down food into usable nutrients for absorption into the blood. Another is circulation which is moving chemicals and cells through the body fluids. The last chemical reaction of metabolism is excretion which is removing waste products.
- The levels of organization of the body (in order). Atoms, molecules, macromolecules, Cells, tissues, organs, organ systems, organism
- 4. The 11 systems, the functions and organs in each system. The 11 systems are: Integumentary, skeletal, muscular, nervous, endocrine, cardiovascular, lymphatic, digestive, respiratory, urinary, and the reproductive system. The organs in the integumentary system are the hair, nails, skin, sweat glands, and sebaceous glands. The functions of these organs in this organ system are to protect underlying tissues, help regulate body temperature, house a variety of sensory receptors, and synthesize certain products. The organs of the skeletal system are the bones, ligaments, and cartilages. The functions of these organs are to bind bones together at joints(cartilage), provide framework, be protective shields for softer tissues, serve as attachments for muscles, and act together with muscles when body parts move. Tissues within bones also produce blood cells and store inorganic salts. The muscle system consists of muscles and tendons. The functions of the organs in the muscle system are to contract and pull their ends closer together which provides the forces necessary to move body parts. Muscles also help maintain posture and are the primary source of heat. The nervous system consists of the brain, spinal cord, nerves, and sense organs. Nerve cells within these organs use a bicelectrical signal called an impulse in combination with a chemical signal to communicate with one another and with muscles and glands. Each neurotransmitter produces a rapid, relatively short-term effect, making it well suited for situations that require immediate, but not necessarily long-lasting, responses. Some nerve cells act in concert with specialized sensory receptors that can detect changes inside and outside of the body. Other nerve cells receive the signals from these sensory units and interpret and act on the information. Still other nerve cells carry signals from the brain or spinal cord to the muscles or glands, causing them to contract or to secrete products in response. The Endocrine system includes all the glands that secrete chemical messengers called hormones. The organs of the endocrine system include the pituitary, thyroid, parathyroid, and adrenal glands, as well as the pancreas, ovaries, testes, pineal gland, and thymus. Hormones travel away from the glands in body fluids such as interstitial fluid and blood. A particular hormone only affects a particular group of cells called its target cells. A hormone alters the metabolism of its target cells. Hormonal effects last longer than those of neurotransmitters. Making them well suited for responses
