 - "The first lesson of economics is scarcity: there is never enough of anything to fully satisfy all those who want it"
 - Is any resource not scarce?
 - Does anyone not have an unlimited set of wants?
- Incentives matter
 - The key principle of economics is that people act in their self-interest when they make decisions
 - This is not the same thing as "greed"
 - For example, parents often spend money on their children instead of buying something for themselves
 - People frequently choose to give money to charity
 - "Joy of Giving" models look at how individuals choose to donate to charity
- Adam Smith (June 16, 1723-June 17, 1790)
 - Adam Smith is the father of modern economics
 - He is from Scotland and wrote two books: The Wealth of Nations (1776), The Theory
 of Moral Sentiments (1759)
 - In The Wealth of Nations, Smith said that self-interest operated line an Invisible Hand that led people to promoting the social interest
 - The idea of the Invisible Hand is a crucial idea in economics that will be discussed in this class from the standpoint of institutions which promote the invisible hand
- ♦ Good Institutions Align the Self Interest with the Social Interest
 - Good institutions are crucial for allowing the invisible hand to transform self-interested actions into social-interest outcomes
 - Poor institutions will not culminate in outcomes that are in the interest of the general public
 - > For instance, look at the two picture of grocery stores on this slide
 - One of the stores is designed to provide the story owners profits
 - The other is designed to get people food
