

CLIMATE ZONES

Climate around the world is based on many factors. Due to the planet's rounded shape, it is colder in the far north and south, and warmer near the equator. Altitude (height above sea level) is also important, as the temperature falls about 0.7°C for every 100m (0.2°F per 1,000 ft). Distance from the surface also has an effect: sea breezes warm up and fall down faster than water. This means that climates towards the centre of the great land masses – the continents – have more extremes of temperature and rainfall, while coastal climates are more moderate, or temperate.

COASTAL AND CONTINENTAL CLIMATES

Lisbon, capital of Portugal in Europe, has a mild coastal climate. The midwinter average is 16°C (61°F) falling to 11°C (52°F) in winter – a difference of 5°C (33°F). About the same distance south of the Equator in Buenos Aires, capital of Argentina in Central America, the continental climate reaches 21°C (70°F) in summer and falls to 1°C (34°F) in winter – a much more extreme range of 20°C (36°F).



MAIN CLIMATE ZONES

There are different systems for naming and mapping climate zones. Some systems have only a few zones (taken from Italy). The detailed version of one of the more systems, the Köppen Climate Classification, has more than 30 types of climate for South America alone. This map uses a much simplified version of the Köppen system based on latitude.

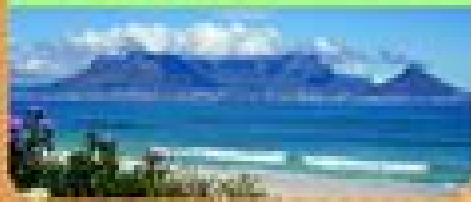

HIGH LATITUDES

Area about halfway between the Polar and the Tropical zone known as the Mid Latitudes. Their climates are generally warm, with dry summers and cool, damp winters, although this can vary greatly depending on distance from the coast. In South Africa, Cape Town (shown) has a mild climate for most of the year. It is influenced by two ocean currents, the cold Benguela from the Atlantic Ocean to the west, and the warm Agulhas from the Indian Ocean to the east.



POLAR REGIONS

The areas around the North and South Poles are colder because the Sun's rays reach them at a shallow, shallow angle so their warmth is spread out. The actual North and South Poles experience extreme seasons as opposite times, with continual Sun in the north for six months of the year, while the south has six months of darkness, and then the reverse. The snow-covered South Pole Station (right) is one of many scientific research stations in the South Pole.



WET IN THE MIDDLE

The Tropic of Cancer is an imaginary line north of the Equator, where the Sun is directly overhead for at least one day each year. The Tropic of Capricorn is similar, but south of the Equator. The area between these two lines is known as the Tropics. Tropical climates are mostly warm all year, often with a rainy season. The island of Sumatra (left) in Southeast Asia is on the Equator itself. It is hot and humid most of the year, with a daily temperature of between 27 and 30°C (81 and 86°F). In northwards are home to some of Earth's greatest diversity of life.
